Open: What is a topic that you enjoy talking about with others?

Read & Discuss: Psalm 96:1-6

1. What do verses 1-3 call God's people to do? What should this look like in everyday life?

2. In verses 4-6, what reasons are given for speaking about God to others? How should these reasons motivate us? What typically motivates you to share the Gospel? How do we cultivate healthy (right and plentiful) motivation within us to share the Gospel?

Read & Discuss: 1 Peter 3:14-16

3. How can we "be prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you" (v. 15)? Given that this is more of a command than a suggestion, what are the implications of this verse for us individually? What are the implications for us corporately?

4. Peter assumes an understanding of the Gospel. What would you say are essential truths of the Gospel? If someone asked why you believe the Gospel, what reasons would you give?

5. From this passage, how would you describe the demeanor that we're to have as we share the Gospel with others? How do we do this when confronted with hostility?

Read & Discuss: John 4:39-42

6. Why might Jesus have decided to reach the townspeople through this woman and not just tell them Himself? Why does God use unlikely people like us to share this good news?

7. How would you describe the focus of the Samaritan woman's testimony (v. 39. See also v. 29)? What was the effect of her testimony (vv. 38-40)? How should her example offer us encouragement as we testify of Christ to others?

Apply: If you do not have one already, create a list of people for whom you will pray and look for opportunities to share the Gospel with.

Pray: Pray that our joy in God will overflow in the declaration of the Gospel to others. Ask God to grant us boldness to seize opportunities to share the Gospel both locally and globally.

Psalm 96:1-6
